We started doing out walk through from the top down to the horses. He invited us into his house where his dogs are kept. There were many kennels and beds for them throughout the property. They also had water available. He showed us his invoices from Equifeeds for his horses. He also showed all his books about birds.

He then took us to his garage where he stored a very good mix of seeds for his birds. We also saw their cat that is free roaming and in good condition.

The birds enclosure was cleaned and they had enough perch spaces. Tony is planning to build them a bigger aviary.

He then took us down to the bottom of his house. There we could see he is busy building new paddocks for his horses. He will first do this and then build shelter. He then told us about this being the first winter they experienced since moving in to the property. When the storm hit, the camps where the horses are kept currently overflowed due to drainage on the road being blocked and them having a dam on their property. The horses had rain jackets on at the time of our visit. They were also not in the camp that was the most wet.

The horses had enough feed and water available and their food were kept in food bins in the enclosures. They are fed oathay and concentrates. The horses are kept as pets. They have 2 grooms that stay on the property as well.

Tony and I agreed that I can revisit on a month's time to see how far he is with building the new enclosures for the horses. This area was chosen as it doesn't flood with heavy rains.
