General Report Comments: Called Riyaad twice but he did not respond. Hugh and I, Elani then waited until 14:30 to knock on the door to see whether anybody was home. We called out and Qadira came out. We saw the brown pitbull in the front yard with a kennel and the yard was clearly cleaned. We did not observe any injuries. Qadira told us her husband is two minutes away and she feels safer for him to be there before letting us in. Riyaad arrived home and we entered the property. The brown pitbull is now kept there Thunder was in the front yard. She had access to a kennel, the yard was clean and her water was kept inside her kennel in the shade. They then let us through to the back yard where the Staffie was kept. The back yard is very large and goes right around the entire house. At the entrance to the back there is a veranda which provides shade and there are water bowls and food present. This dog is much older and is starting to walk more stiff due to age. He is still in good condition. He did not appear to have any obvious injuries. As Thunder was infested with fleas, I also educated the owners about which products to buy for the environment and dogs for ticks and fleas such as Karbadust, Bravecto and Nexguard. Riyaad made me write it on his cellphone to remember. There were no contraventions of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 and the owners complied. To close the case.
