General Report Comments: I, Elani arrived at the property and met with Mrs Burger and two other women.

They showed me that their cat was stuck in a storm drain. They also informed me that their cat got into contact with a poison called Paraguard that is used for their tomato farming practices which is illegal in other countries.

They went to their veterinarian who said that it is a slow death and the cat will definitely die. I then called WAGH for a second opinion where they confirmed that there is no antidote for this type of poison. It is a slow absorbant killer and the cat will most certainly die from it.

We tried putting pipes together with a closed end in order to push the cat out of the drain from the other side. Whilst doing this or getting a strong hose pipe, the cat came out itself and was caught by the owners niece. We confined the cat in stacked crates and closed it with cable ties. I could smell infection.

They signed the cat over for euthanasia. It was then euthanized by the SPCA and took quite a long time to stop moving after intravenous euthanasia.
