General Report Comments: Hugh, Insp Navesh Singh (Nspca Farm Unit), Insp DJ White (Nspca Farm Unit) and I, Elani arrived at the goat dairy farm for a routine insoection. We met Linda and introduced ourselves.

Upon inspection, we observed male goats kept seperate from female goats who are the main financial gain. They mainly have Saanen and Alpine goats. The premises is massive and each enclosure has a large building/house as sleeping quarters for the goats.

We then went to where the goats get milked. The staff were on lunch whilst we were there so no goats were being milked.

They milk goats twice a day and the machines weigh the goats and read the milk contents to say whether it might be too thick or if something is wrong. This area was very clean and all the equipment was in good working order.

The welfare of the animals are well looked after. Linda uses Dr Malan (Statevet) for regular visits.

No welfare concerns in terms of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 were found.
