She first claimed its her sons dog and then later she stated its all of rheir dog. She couldn't answer me as to why they have the sog. She also made up an excuse for not buying Shoo fly yet first stating they get paid the 25th and then admitting that Jevandre gets paid bi weekly.

I then explained in detail that according to the APA 71 of 1962 she is the owner of the dog when he is not there. She claimed she cannot clean and will get somebody to do it and I told her that she has legs and arms and can throw rubbish away in their bin.

Rocco also didnt have water and we made her fill the bucket and explained what they can do in order to prevent the bowl from being knocked over.

I also explained that I can seize the dog and prosecute them if they do not comply and will give them less time to fix what they need to .

I issued a FINAL warning to:

- 1)Move the kennel to shaded area for Rocco
- 2) Clean Roccas living environment from hazardous material (rocks, cushion, rubbish, wood) within 48 hours
- 3) Rocco did not have access to potable water. Ensure he always has access to drinking water.
- 4) Ensure to provide Rocco with adequate tick and flea treatment within 48 hours (Nexguard and Bravecto)

Carol signed the warning and we left.
