We then went to the water troughs and we noticed that there were faeces just on the outside .She then mentioned that the property is not hers and the owner usually comes by to collect it.He uses it for compost and we advised her to move it away from the horses because it causes many flies.All horses had fly masks.

We then walked to the outside and saw lucerne bails standing outside .She then mentioned that she takes these bails out in the morning and only feeds lucerne due to her veterinarian advising this. We also suggested getting more fly traps as she only had one.She then agreed and told us we could go check her grazing site.

We then went to the grazing site and we saw oathey laying on the ground .She then mentioned that they waste it like that and has been laying there ever since. We also spotted a shelter at the top and we asked her about this.She then mentioned that the owner will move her and her horses to a new farm which they bought.I then told her about adding springs to the roof and this protects it from the wind damaging it.She then understood and we went back down. We saw a shelter on the outside of the area where horses are kept and she mentioned that the sheep sleep in there at night.

We then went down to her equipment room and we saw that all her riding gear was neat and clean.She showed us her medicines aswell and grooming equipment. She then offered to take us to the new farm which was bought by the owner of the property.

We then drove there and saw a large farm.This farm was being heavily renovated and we walked to the area where the horses would be kept. We then saw that they were busy building stables and when asked when everything would be done she informed us that it would only be done by next year.

We then went back down and she took us on a trail where she would be walking with the horses.This is a large area and we then spoke to her about shelters.She then mentioned that she had been asking the owner constantly but he refused as she is going to move to the new farm. We then mentioned that she should ask him for shelter due to her only moving within the next year.She then understood.
