Report/Findings: 18/04/2026 Both dogs were found roaming freely inside the property. The dogs can willingly go inside the house. Owner said the dogs were not kept for days inside the garage but only when gardener is busy. She could not give us the valid reason for keeping the dogs in when gardener is around as the dogs are friendly. We also recommended enrichment and the lady (owner) seemed to be sitting alone and busy.
