For quite some time now, there has been a dog inside that complex that barks non-stop—day and night. It doesn't sound like occasional or reactive barking; it seems distressed, and it's been going on regularly enough to raise concern that the dog might be neglected, anxious, or otherwise in distress.

Unfortunately, I don't know which unit the dog is in, but the barking can be heard from outside the complex and continues for long periods at a time.

I'm sharing this out of genuine concern for the wellbeing of the animal. I would rather report it and find out that everything is okay than risk a situation where a dog is being mistreated or left to suffer.
