In light of our inspection conducted on the 20th of November 2023, the following concerns were observed and must be rectified **within the following 7 days**.

You are hereby warned that:

MACASSAR SITE (situated at SSB Mining, Macassar Dunes, off Macassar Road, Khayelitsha):

1. The K9 enclosures/cages were observed to be too small, primarily with the large kennel that is placed inside the enclosure/cage as the kennel absorbs the majority of the animal's roaming space.
 - a. The enclosures/cages must either be enlarged to accommodate the dog with the kennel, an appropriate/recommended enclosure/cage size is 4000mm (length) x 2000mm (width) x 1800 (height).
2. The enclosures/cages are placed on sand, which is not acceptable. The floor of an enclosure/cage must be constructed of solid material, for example, concrete flooring as this will aid in better hygiene maintenance and draining.
 - a. Concrete/solid flooring with suitable drainage must be implemented.
3. The enclosures/cages are situated in a sand environment and likely expose the dogs to dusty conditions, which can cause unnecessary eye irritations and/or infections.
 - a. The lower section of the enclosures/cages must be covered, strong weatherproof net/shade cloth can be used.

BLACKHEATH SITE (situated at 20 Artisan Way, Blackheath):

1. The transportation vehicle was observed to have no non-slip flooring inside, which can cause the dogs to easily slip and unnecessarily harm themselves in transit.
 - a. Ensure installation of non-slip flooring inside the cages used for transportation.

This warning has been issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 169 of 1993.

Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 and/or Performing Animals Protection Act 24 of 1935.

Any person who:- obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.
