Upon my and Inspector page arrival at the saleyard we observed through all the sheep, goats and cattle, while doing our rounds we observed 2 sheep and a goat that was compromised, we immediately asked them to isolate the animals so that they can be humanely euthanized of which they isolated the animals but as we did our rounds ended up selling the animals. We approached Carl about slaughtering the animals but he told us nobody is allowed to slaughter on the property as they get into trouble with the health inspectors

We asked multiple people to supply the animals with water at 13:30 but they just ignored us, we even told the branch manager and supervisor named Carl and Hanis to tell the workers to give the cattle water but nobody did anything, at 20:30 the cattle still didn't get water....
