



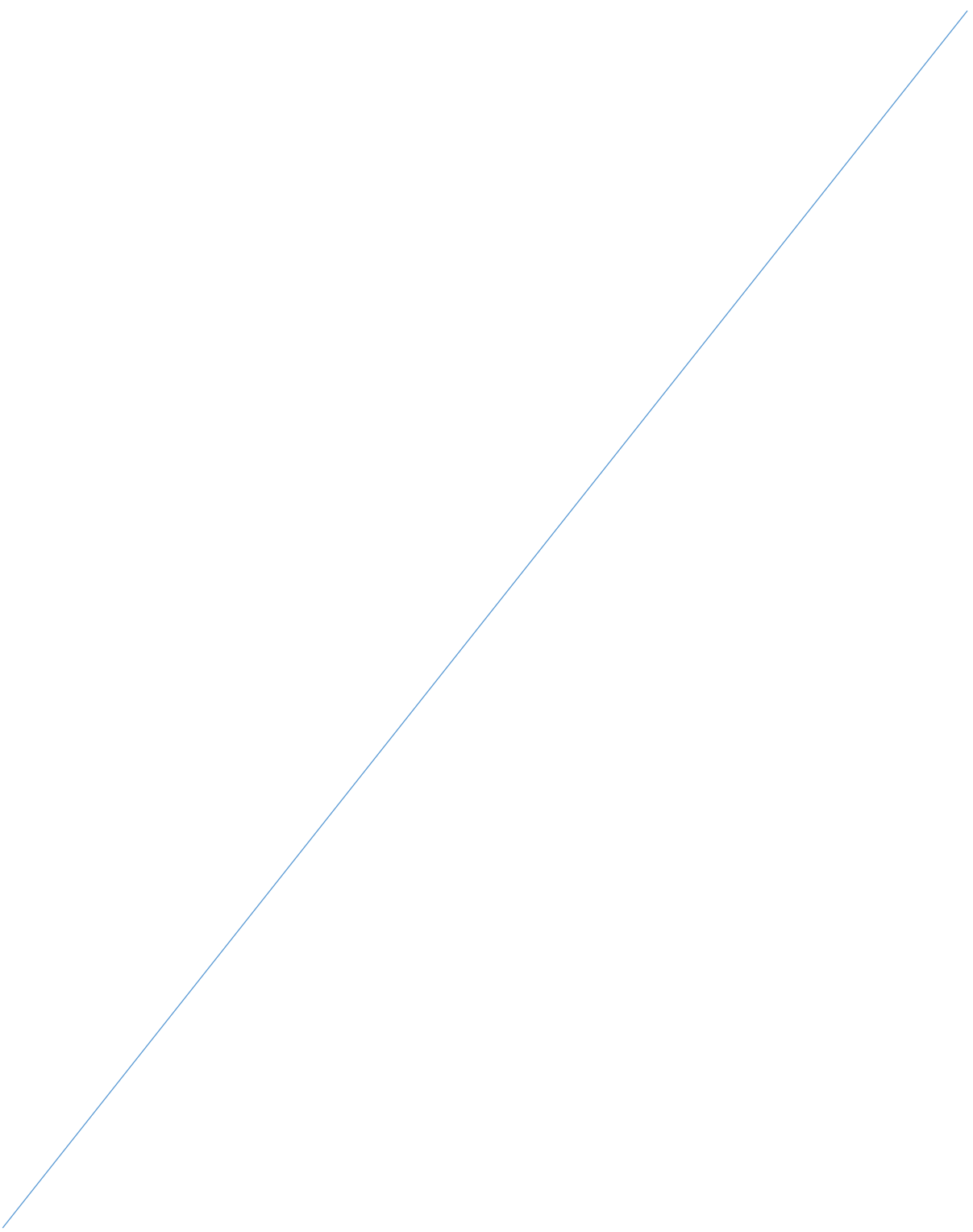

You are hereby warned that:

1. Repair and maintain the enclosures of the dogs as loose and protruding wires were observed:
 - a. These dangerous/injurious objects must be removed and/or properly covered as they could lead to unnecessary pain and suffering.
2. There was a fly trap suspended from the ceiling of the enclosure where the second dog was in:
 - a. The fly trap needs to be removed from the said enclosure and placed in a suitable spot, away from the dogs and not directly inside the enclosures.
3. A bag was found standing close to the food stock of the dogs. Upon closer inspection, it was observed that the bag had faeces inside:
 - a. This is unacceptable because the faeces attract flies and other parasites. The faeces must be removed and disposed of properly;
4. A disinfectant product must be used that is sufficient for the cleaning of the dog's enclosures.
5. There was a dog in the back of the building, in the alleyway. This dog did not have access to adequate shelter:
 - a. You are to provide this dog with adequate shelter to protect him against all weather conditions.
6. As discussed previously (refer to Warning #16712), three of the dogs at the aforesaid address are not used for any safeguarding purposes. This means the dogs are caged unnecessarily; it is evident that these dogs are going through unnecessary pain and suffering:
 - a. The enclosures where the dogs are kept need to be taken down and the dogs are to be free roaming in the property at all times;
 - b. The three dogs in question needs to be taken to a registered veterinarian for veterinary assessment and a report on their health must be provided to the SPCA;
 - c. You also have the option of surrendering these three dogs to the Cape of Good Hope SPCA

Ensure to comply with the above within 7 days, unless indicated otherwise per point.



This warning has been issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act No 169 of 1993.

Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 and / or Performing Animals Protection Act No 24 of 1935.

Any person who:- obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.
