

## Insurance Report

**Horse:** Albracca – 17 year old, Grey, Thoroughbred, Gelding

**Owner:** Sasha Lotz - Habib

**Diagnosis:**

To certify that I examined this horse on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of May 2023 and found the following:

- i. Poor condition – body score 2/5.
- ii. Had a mucopurulent Right nasal discharge.
- iii. Severe petechial haemorrhages and mild icterus of the ocular mucous membranes.

I examined his buccal cavity with the aid of a gag and found bilateral mandibular last molar teeth with long hooks.

I treated him with antibiotics, NSAID's and recommend:

- i. Dental therapy by a technician as soon as possible.
- ii. Antibiotics for 7 days.
- iii. Diet advice:
  - a. Increase quality of roughage
  - b. Increase quantity of roughage and concentrates.

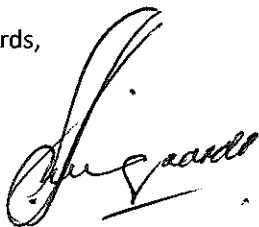
**Discussion:**

In my opinion this horse's poor condition is due to

- i. A viraemia in the past 7 – 10 days.
- ii. In combination of inadequate roughage
- iii. The possible sinus infection.

I will reassess the horse in four weeks.

**Horse:** Ping – 17 year old, Bay, Thoroughbred, Gelding

**Diagnosis:**

To certify that I examined this horse on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of May 2023 and found the following:

- i. A body score of 1.5 / 5.
- ii. Severe petechial haemorrhages and icterus of ocular mucous membranes.

All vitals and cardiac function were normal.

I advised the exact same dietary changes as for Albracca.

In my opinion the cause of his loss of condition is the same as Albracca except for the possible sinus infection.

I will also revisit and examine this horse in June.

**Diagnosis:**

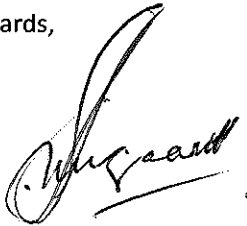
To certify that I examined this horse on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of May 2023 and found the following:

- i. A body score of 3/5.
- ii. Mucous membranes mildly icterus.

In my opinion the same cause for his mild weight loss applies as in Abracca and Ping. The same diet recommendations hold for him. I believe his prognosis is good.

I will examine him in June as well.

### Diagnosis:

To certify that I examined this horse on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of May 2023 and found the following:

- i. A body score of 2.5/5.
- ii. Severe petechial haemorrhages and icterus of ocular mucous membranes.

In my opinion he suffered the same cause as the other 3 horses and therefore, the exact same dietary advice was given. He has a good prognosis.
