Facility Inspection

On 20th June 2023 Dr Lee Baragwanath inspected the above-mentioned premises and examined the following animals:

- **Goose, male with grey head:** Intermittent lameness on the left. On examination the goose was sound. NSAID such as petcam will be dispensed if the goose starts limping again and then radiographs if it persists. Recommendation for now is to monitor.
- **Mr Frizzles:** He is over grooming/preening which was acknowledge during the clinical. Suspect behavioural disorder. Scheduled medication on order to address the behavioural issues and deworming treatment.
- **Grey ringneck parrot:** Chronic self-mutilation/feather plucking. This parrot was dropped off roughly two weeks ago with no feathers around the head and areas of raw bleeding spots. This is a stress/behavioural issue and we have prescribed serenace at 2mg/kg BID. We are going to administer vitamin ACE and monitor his progress. We have advised that he be placed under an infrared light. Once he has recovered, he can be placed in the quieter avery along with Harry, the African Grey.

Recommendations:

Deworm all birds with piperazine at 0,24g/kg.

Annual site inspections and Cape Vet will attend to any routine care when required.
