Comments: Kim called Jaco while we were in his office.

She said that the animals are given 2l of food daily and the pups are given 500ml of water and 14 scoops of a royal canin mixture with colostrum (that has been developed for her) over 3 to 4 hours. She also said that the animals are given pilchards, but Amos said they were fed sardines.

She further stated that Amos had noticed the seal before we did, which, if true, nothing had been done. He called her once we had all noticed the seal. And that "they convulse, they die".

Kim went on to speak about where the seals are released and that they are not habituated and they tag each animal, and they have 22 animals, and there was 54 that came in with the pandemic. She said that the pups only have a 10% chance of survival.

The feeding occurs between 3 and 4 pm.

She seemed upset that we conducted an inspection and that we further, didn't arrange it with her.
