Good morning Mr Moatlhodi,

We hope this email finds you well this morning!

My colleague, Inspector Lee Prins, and I met you at Bellville Magistrate Court the week before last on Friday, 24 November 2023 whilst we were looking for our Prosecutor, Mr Bloemfontein.

We'd just like to take this opportunity to express our sincere gratitude. Thank you so much for taking the time to assist us regarding one of our cases which had recently been removed from the roll. We truly appreciate the manner with which you accommodated us.

Please see below the brief revival of what we had discussed.

One of the cases opened by the Cape of Good Hope SPCA (COGH SPCA) had been removed from the court roll on 08 November 2023. Inspector Prins attended court that day and recalls that the Magistrate stated he was removing the case from the roll due to the case's trial having been postponed an excessive amount of times. Unfortunately, the COGH SPCA's witnesses were unable to attend court due to a mix up of dates. However, this is the first and only time that the trial was postponed by fault of the COGH SPCA. All the other times that the trial was postponed was not a result of COGH SPCA's. You informed us that the case can be re-enrolled. We also left a copy of the attached summons with you.

Could you please further assist us by advising how we can go about to confirm if the case has been placed back on the roll?
