General Report Comments: Upon arrival I met owner's daughter who told me her father is not home, but at work. I then asked her to give me her father's number which she did so I contacted him and asked for permission for him to allow her to give me access onto property which he did.

I then observed both dogs on the property including the dog in question he appeared not to be putting weight on his right front foot. Thr other dog also appeared to have a limp in his back legs. The dogs have access to adequate water and shelter, but their living area is covered in old feaces.

I then issued a NTC for the owner: Provide your dog with the possible broken leg with adequate veterinary treatment within 24hours.

2) Provide proof of such treatment provided to the Cape of Good Hope SPCA within provided time frame.

3) Provide your bigger dog with adequate veterinary treatment within 48hours as she appears to have a limp with her back legs .

4) Provide proof of such treatment within given time frame.

5)Clean living area within 24hours and ensure the feaces gets cleaned regularly.

6)Should you not be able to provide treatment for your animals you have the option to surrender them to the Cape of Good Hope SPCA.

7) In future as the owner of an animal ensure when that animal is in need of veterinary treatment it is provided without any delay as denying your animal veterinary treatment is a contravention of the Animals Protection Act no.71 of 1962.
