Yes - 2 sheep with nasal discharge. The sheep were slaughtered immediately after Natasha and I pointed them out to Nabelah.

General comments:

They were not yet slaughtering for Qurbani and were still preparing for Qurbani. Natasha rectified mishandling by the workers of the farm and explained and showed them how to properly capture and carry the sheep that needed to be slaughtered (a minimum of 2 people handling each sheep so as to carry humanely). Natasha and I then watched them restrain the animals to be slaughtered (the 2 sheep with nasal discharge) and noted that the sheep were restrained by their legs being tethered to the slaughter cart but in an acceptable manner. The slaughterer used was competent and managed to cut both arteries with the first stroke. Natasha then asked how long they wait before they dress the carcass and we clarified bleeding times with them and Natasha also taught them how to check for corneal reflexes.
