To whom it may concern

On Friday, 28 June 2024 at approximately 15h10, SPCA Inspector Lee presented me with a dog collected from Kraaifontein, Cape Town.

ANIMAL DETAILS

Species: Canine

Sex: Female, unsterilised

Age: Adult (exact age unknown)

Description: Black/Tan

Identification: A32260

EXAMINATION FINDINGS

- **Description**

She presented with a mass hanging out her vulva. An impression smear was done and this suggested an infected TVT (vacuolated round cells and neutrophils). She also had fleas. Her blood smear showed a eosinophilia and neutrophilia.

- **Duration** of the condition - Chronic

- **Cause** of the condition

In my experience, this results due to a non-sterilized female being mounted when she is on heat.

- **Prognosis** - Fair with treatment.

- **Recommendation** – In my opinion, this animal should either undergo vincristine treatment and receive antibiotics and anti-inflammatories, and eventually be spayed (and in the meantime kept separate from males), or she should be euthanised as this is a very painful condition if left untreated.

COMMENTS

In my opinion this animal: this animal has suffered unnecessarily.
