I also attach hereto a copy of the warning that was issued and emailed to Sandy's Eden on 13 December 2023. A proactive inspection can be conducted by the NSPCA when one of your Inspectors are in the area again.

This facility is really trying hard to maintain the best possible standards for the animals. I was rather surprised at how clean the kennels were and how neat the areas where the animals are housed and their food, etc, are being kept. This facility is also not a "no kill" shelter and do euthanise animals on a weekly basis.

It was mentioned to us that the Winelands SPCA has tendered and hope to be awarded the tender to take over the pound function and property. This is going to be a huge task for such a small SPCA, and if this is the case, I truly hope they know what they are letting themselves in for, as this is not going to be an easy task.
