Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Lwazi Ntungele of Cape of Good Hope SPCA met with the owner of the dog, Mr Kurt Hardnick, who granted us access to the property. We observed the dogs in question, fair body condition and now on a running chain of adequate length. The chain goes from the back of the property all the way to the front, giving the dog ample space to move and exhibit its natural behaviour. The chain connecting the dog to the line is still quite a bit short but they have an extra leash that will be attached to it and it will extend it enough to be suitable. The dog also has a suitable collar on now as well. The dog had access to shelter and water, however the water was still slightly a bit dirty and the shelter they have was somewhat fixed but still not adequate. I educated them that they should clean out the water bucket more and ensure the water in there stays clean as much as possible. Also, the shelter does not seem like it will be okay for the dog as he is quite a large dog and the roof of the shelter sits too low now. The owner agreed that they will try to make an alternative arrangement for the shelter. Seeing as they have basically complied, I did not issue a warning further but told them I will come to check the water, the chain length connecting to the dog and the shelter in next week.
