Confinement of animal/s: Static chain - inadequate length ***

Reason for being chained or caged: Aggressive, causes damage in the property

Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Lwazi Ntungele of Cape of Good Hope SPCA met with the wife of the owner of the dog, Mrs Brittney Matthews, who granted us access to the property.

We observed an adult female Pitbull dog, fair body condition and but still on a static chain of inadequate length. The dog had access to adequate shelter and water. The living area however had an accumulation of old faeces. Mrs Matthews said they had received they notice left on their gate and they are busy getting everything for the running chain. She also informed us that they will be putting up a wall that separates the front yard and the back yard, then the dog will have free roaming access to the front yard. We told her that will be great for the dog, and the running chain will be good to have in the meantime until the wall is done. I also told her they will need to clean the property of all the dirt and the accumulated faeces, and to maintain the cleanliness. The dog no longer had a raw chain around his neck, it now has a strong collar on around its neck, which shows they have already complied with one part of the warning left previously.

I issued a warning, 21817, to:

- Unchain the animal immediately to roam freely inside the property, or place the dog on a running chain within 7 days.
- Clean and hygienically maintained the animal's living environment within 7 days.

The warning was consigned by myself and Inspector Lwazi Ntungele. The warning was signed and accepted by Mrs Brittney Matthews on behalf of her husband, Mr Robert Jooste.
