Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Lee Prins from the Cape of Good Hope SPCA met with the owner, Mrs Isabella Loesa, who granted us access to the property. I observed the adult dog in question, still in fair body condition and free roaming on the property. The owner stated the puppy is with her son by his friend's house. The dogs still make use of the house as shelter, where they have free access to and where there is clean water available for them. However, the back yard section is now clean and open for them to safely and hygienically wander in. I thanked the owner for sorting all that dirt out and it seems like a nice space for the dogs to use. I spoke to the owner about sterilization again, but she said she is still hesitant about the sterilization of the adult male dog. She said she won't mind for the puppy when she's older though. I reiterated the By-law contravention of keeping the dog unsterilized, but she did not change her mind.

Therefore, from the welfare side this case can be closed. However, I have reported the property to the City of Cape Town's Law Enforcement Animal Control Unit for the unsterilized adult male dog.
