Dear Simone

We trust this email finds you well. See below as first feedback for the matter you brought to our attention.

On 03 December 2025, the inspector met the domestic worker who was caring for the property while the owners were away. The dog, Hunter, was in fair condition with access to food, water and a clean space, but he had no shelter. He was also shedding heavily and showed signs of breathing discomfort with a scratchy throat. The worker was instructed to provide shelter, groom the dog and obtain veterinary treatment, and a notice to comply was issued.

On 07 December 2025, the dog had been moved to the back of the property where he remained free roaming but still without proper shelter, although the original shelter notice had not yet expired. The dog continued to pant throughout the inspection, and veterinary care had still not been provided. A warning was issued to obtain veterinary treatment within 48 hours.
