Comments:	Upon arrival on scene, I met with Chief Adele from the Fire and Rescue Department. She informed me that she had witnessed a severely burnt pig and a dog running away from the fire. Unfortunately, the pig had sustained extensive burns. I also found Justine from Horse and Dog Rescue on scene. She had been asked by Inspector Mark Syce to attend and assist. She secured the dog and monitored the condition of the pig until my arrival. The pig was thereafter humanely shot and slaughtered to end its suffering. Only one farmer, who owned 15 pigs and two dogs, was affected. Eleven of his pigs died in the fire, in addition to the one I had to slaughter. Only three pigs remained, which he subsequently relocated to an unknown location. During a sweep of the affected area, only two dead tortoises were found. Another sweep was done this morning to ensure that there werent anymore animals still left suffering due to the fire. No further action required
