Dear Adele

Thank you for your email, which has been referred to me for a response.

We will arrange for a follow-up inspection to be conducted at 23 Gail Arendse, Macassar (it is not 28 as per your email below).

Regarding unsterilised animals on properties where owners refuse to comply, such cases are reported to Law Enforcement for further action. We encourage all organisations to follow the same process and to conduct appropriate follow-ups. The responsibility for addressing these matters cannot rest solely with the SPCA, as our resources and manpower are limited and do not allow for continuous follow-up on every reported case.

As previously communicated, if your organisation has the capacity to facilitate the sterilisation process, we respectfully request that you do so where possible.

@Inspectorate – Cape of Good Hope SPCA please re-open INSP207309 (this is the original case) for the Inspector to do a follow-up and establish if the owners want to sterilise.
