While collecting animals in the informal settlement for sterilisation, Inspector Davids and I also conducted the follow-up inspection for the veterinary concerns regarding the two cats.

After the owner Mrs. Carollissen allowed us access to the property, we observed that there was water available, adequate shelter and space and the living environment appeared to be clean.

We asked the owner if she had managed to take the two cats to a veterinary clinic yet. She informed us that she was not able to yet.

I explained to her that Inspector Davids would now issue a final warning and that failure to comply may result in further action being taken. I explained that she does have the option to surrender the cats over to the SPCA but she was unwilling. I informed her that because it is a final warning, failure to comply will result in warrant being obtained from the Magistrate of that district and the cats will be removed and a case of animal cruelty may be opened against her.

Further I stressed to her that the warning was issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 169 of 1993 and that failure to comply may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962.

The owner said that she understands and would try her utmost to procure veterinary attention.

Inspector Davids issued a final warning to:

1. Take your two cats named Saprky (ginger/white) and Mother Cat (tabby) to a veterinary clinic within 24 hours and provide proof thereof.
