While conducting unrelated follow-up inspections in the area, the owner Mr. Anthony Wanewich flagged us down and informed us that he has the pitbull with the veterinary concerns on the property.

Inspector Davids and I examined the dog and there were large growths and lesions on the genitals that appeared to be cancerous in nature. We informed the owner that the dog is currently suffering and if he cannot afford veterinary treatment, it would be in the best interests of the dog to surrender it over to the SPCA and the owner chose that option.

We also conducted an inspection of the two xbreed dogs on the property, they both appeared to have gained weight quite quickly and appeared to be in a fair condition. The living environment had been cleaned, there was water available and adequate shelter.

Inspector Davids issued a warning to:

1. For future reference, whenever your animals appear to be sick or injured, you must procure adequate veterinary treatment without unnecessary delay.
