Please describe the concern you have

I am writing to lodge a formal complaint regarding the ongoing neglect and mistreatment of several dogs at a property in my road. I request that my identity remain anonymous, as the owner is known to be aggressive.

The occupants of the property appear to be engaged in dog breeding, specifically with Boerboel dogs. There is a female dog kept at the back of the house who has been repeatedly bred. To my knowledge, she has been forced into at least four consecutive pregnancies, which is extremely dangerous and inhumane. I have also learned that the most recent litter of puppies has died.

The general conditions at the property are unfit for animals:

The environment is consistently filthy, with dog feces left in the front yard creating a terrible stench.

The female breeding dog is kept in an unhygienic and unsuitable area.

At night, one of the dogs is confined to a small space between the front door and gate, which is highly restrictive and cruel.

I have personally witnessed the owner physically hitting the dogs in an aggressive manner.

I understand there was a previous SPCA complaint regarding this household some years ago . Unfortunately, most neighbors are afraid to come forward due to the owner's aggressive behavior (specifically the owner of the dogs named Temblin), but I feel strongly that the animals' welfare requires urgent intervention.

I respectfully request that the SPCA investigate this matter as soon as possible , even just going to take a look at the property should help.
