The SPCA conducted an inspection on 27 January 2026 and saw the same dogs as per previous inspections. The inspector assessed all the dogs and found all of them free of injury and discomfort and all the dogs were healthy. The dog with abscess was found to be in good condition as well with no negative impacts of the abscess notes previously. The owner has complied with the demands of the SPCA - the case has been closed.
