We attended to the case on 2 February 2026, see findings below: Our inspector was allowed access to the property by the owner of the animals. When questioned about the cat incident, the owner denied it all. Our inspector did a thorough inspection of the dogs and their living conditions and found they had access to drinkable water, adequate shelter, food and a clean living environment. There was one dog who appeared to be overweight and had a wound on the side of her abdomen. The owner was issued with a Notice to Comply to provide the dog with adequate veterinary treatment and to enquire about the dog's weight as it could have a negative impact on her health.
