We would like to inform you that we managed to get an address in connection with the information you provided below. However, upon inspection, our inspector found that the property looked different to that in the video. There were no signs of the red car as seen in the video, and there were no signs of any dogs being on the property. We spoke to the owner of the property and he admitted to posting the video on his socials but he was not the original creator of the video. He claimed that he saw it on someone's post and made a meme from it, which is what you reported to us.

Unfortunately, with limited information and not knowing where the actual address is, we are unable to continue with our investigation. The case was therefore closed. If we do, however get new verified information about the whereabouts of the dog, then we will intervene.
