Name: What A Babe

DOB: 2019

Markings: Dark bay. Small irregular white star on the forehead off center to the right.

Microchip: None

Status: Brood mare, has a 5 month old filly.

Clinical evaluation:

Temperature: 38.4° C

Pulse: 48bpm

Respiration: 22bpm

Lung auscultation: clear

Mucous membranes: pmg

Ticks: none observed

Paralumbar fossa auscultation: normal motility

Hydration: normal

BCS: 4/9

Hooves: all four hooves are overgrown, no shoes present

Gait: no obvious lameness observed

Faeces: Normal in colour and consistency

Diagnostic tests:

Bloodsmear: No abnormalities detected.

Feecal egg count: Eimeria oocysts observed.

Markings: Liver chestnut. Flea bitten pattern on left hand side rump. White sock on left hind limb from hoof to fetlock. Small irregular white star on the forehead.

Status: Brood mare, has a 5 month old filly.

Clinical evaluation: could not be completed in full. A "handsoff" exam was performed due to the mare's nature.

Ticks: none observed

Hydration: normal

BCS: 4/9

Hooves: all four hooves are overgrown, no shoes present

Gait: lame on frontlimb, suspected due to overgrown hooves

Mare 3:

Name: Why Me

DOB: 02/2021

Markings: Chestnut with flaxen mane and tail. Small irregular white star on the forehead.

Microchip: None

Status: Brood mare, has a 5 month old filly.

Clinical evaluation: could not be completed in full. A "handsoff" exam was performed due to the mare's nature.

Ticks: none observed

Hydration: normal

BCS: 4/9

Hooves: all four hooves are overgrown, no shoes present

Gait: no obvious lameness observed

Overall comments and recommendations:

Taking into regard that all three mares have a foal close to weaning age, that are in good body condition score, these mares' body weight is expected for their life stage. Recommend to arrange a farrier visit as soon as possible. To feed ad-lib oat hay bales (haver bale) for the horses in the stables and in the outdoor camp. All the horses can also be treated with a dewormer such as 'Pegamax' or 'Pegaforte'.
