Subject: Puppy neglect

Good afternoon
I trust you are well
I would like to put in a complaint for animal neglect or abuse. unfortunately I have put in a complaint twice but at a different spca but have not heard anything back.

We live on a small holding with several houses and one of the houses the owner has a puppy - now for a bit of background a couple of months ago he's previous two dogs were taken away due to neglect. He then got this puppy. It's a Pitbull puppy which is about six or seven months old, beautiful pup. Unfortunately the reason I am reaching out again is because we are hearing the puppy cry literally the whole night and day. He has also broken out before, out of a pallet fence (he's blocked off with a pallet fence) trying to scratch the bins for food.

The puppy is extremely thin. You can see every single rib on both sides. The one guy that lives with them in a room says that the dog does not have any kind of shelter so when it's extremely hot or raining the pup doesn't have shelter. If the pup cries too much, he gets locked up for about two or three days in a room and then just has to pee/poop in the room.

I sometimes feed the dog. I throw some food over the fence. Unfortunately the owner has screamed at everyone on the farm saying that no one is allowed to feed his dog and if he finds out anyone is feeding his dog he will make sure that person's dog will no longer be alive or staying with them. Last week the guy that stays with him called me looking for food for the dog - he said the owner hasn't feed the dog in four days.

I don't know if the dog has gotten food since then the dog has been crying the whole time for the last few days.

He stays at 26 Bluegum street, Unit 5, Klipheuwel
