Comments:

The complainant stated that she is very disappointed with the way this case has been handled and feels that the concerns she previously raised have not been adequately addressed.

She advised that dog fighting remains an ongoing concern at the property. As she works from home, she is not always able to leave immediately to record evidence when incidents occur. On the occasions when she has attempted to do so, the altercations had already ended by the time she was able to get outside.

The complainant reported that a black-and-white pit bull is kept chained at the front of the property. According to her, this dog was involved in a dog-fighting incident during the middle of last week. She stated that while the dogs were being separated, this particular dog would not release its grip and was subsequently stabbed in the head.

She further alleged that later that afternoon, the dog was removed from the property and taken to another nearby property for treatment of its injuries. Since the incident, she has observed that the dog appears lethargic, spends most of its time lying down, and struggles to walk, with its hind legs reportedly collapsing when it stands.

The complainant also expressed concern regarding the welfare of the dogs, alleging that they are not fed daily but only every second day.

Dogs observed on the property:

Black-and-white dog (front of property): Allegedly used as a target dog in dog-fighting activities.
Brown-and-white dog (rear of property): Reportedly a fairly new addition to the property.
