Comments:	This case was discussed with the supervisory team and, due to the significant public concern and attention it has received on social media, it was decided that an early intervention at the location would be in the best interest of the animals involved. Numerous reports and social media posts have alleged that dogs are suffering from severe skin conditions, roaming freely, lacking access to adequate food and water, breeding uncontrollably, being involved in dog fighting activities, and living without suitable shelter. A large-scale intervention has therefore been arranged, with the assistance of multiple stakeholders and partner entities. During the outreach, animals will be brought in for sterilisation, and the mobile team will assist with rabies vaccinations, deworming, and flea treatment. Multiple inspectors will also be deployed to support and monitor the intervention.
