Subject: URGENT: Unvisited Cruelty Report & Critical Animal & Child Emergency – 18 Polo Close Beacon valley Mitchells Plain Cape Town

Dear Inspectorate Management,

I am writing to urgently escalate a high-priority animal cruelty report lodged for the property located at (18 Polo Close Beacon Valley Mitchells Plain Cape Town)

An inspector was scheduled to visit this address today, (Monday 3rd of August) , but no one arrived.

We understand the inspectorate handles a high volume of calls , but we are deeply concerned as the animals on this property remain in active, life-threatening danger due to Robyn's Neighbours who live at (14 Polo Close Beacon Valley).

Her dog has just arrived home today from the vet and it is crucial that these neighbours do not go near this dog ever again!

One of the children that lives at her neighbours house (14 Polo Close) told her and her son that the people taking care of him also let his dogs bite the children in that house if they do something wrong. And that they are constantly taking drugs. This is unacceptable and an urgent matter that needs to be taken care of!

They have already killed her previous dog, Please do not let them do the same to the dog that she has now. He has multiple wounds on him due to what the neighbours have done to him.

And the children next door are living in a drug-filled household with people using their animals to abuse them.

She reported it now because she had no idea what to do beforehand, I was the one who helped her and gave her every detail of who to call. She was fearful that they would do something worse.

Please help her and please help her animals and the children at that house!

Summary of the Emergency:

Location:

18 Polo Close Beacon Valley Mitchells Plain Cape Town (Robyn Oppermans House)

14 Polo Close Beacon Valley Mitchells Pain Cape Town (Abusers House)

Their names are: Lehaandro Sass, Kiyaam Van Wyk & Cresindo Arnoldus (Girlfriend of Lehaandro) included in the pictures.

Nature of Offence: Severe physical abuse and active killing of dogs on the property by neighbours.

Evidence: Unedited photographic evidence exists documenting severe physical injuries and cruelty involving the occupants. Including vet reports that were not given to Robyn because she did not get a reference number from you guys.

The Vet: Phillipi Veterinary Clinic (Aws of SA)

Additional Safety Risks: The property involves illegal drug activity, severe neglect, and dogs being used aggressively against children on the premises.

Due to the safety risks and potential volatile nature of the occupants, we urge the inspectorate to prioritise a site visit—with SAPS escort if necessary—to assess the condition of the animals and confiscate them if warranted under the Animals Protection Act.

We have the digital photo evidence ready to hand over securely to the attending inspector .

Please contact us as soon as possible to confirm when an officer can be dispatched .
