Hi Inspectors

Over the weekend I was in contact with the person on duty. This female dog named Leas has been running around with 3 very young boys at the intersections in Rondebosch, specifically on the corner of Palmyra and Keurboom Roads and Campground and Belmont roads. It sleeps all day and very scared, tail constantly between legs. It has almost gotten hit by cars too. Many of us keep feeding it as the boys beg for money and I've been informed for drugs (cannot know if true or not). It seems quite scared when I put water down too.

One of the boys was more open to talk to me and he did speak to the person on duty on Saturday afternoon in Xhosa. Apparently the person is a friend of his who owns the dog and lives a few houses down from the boy's house in Langa, he gave the address. You may ask the man who was on duty for the address. He said they would go check it out/investigate as there are other dogs there too. They bring no water or food for her when they beg up to 10 hours or more and it's a long walk as she is exhausted. They bring her to use to get money. She has a big bump on her side too. The other boy says sometimes she stays at their place and sleeps at them. So it is all uncertain.

Please may you follow up with the inspector on duty and please investigate at the address and let me know, thank you very much.
