The one dog is a small Maltese poodle that is old,sick,def, can't walk properly and his hair is falling out. The second dog is a bit bigger but I'm not sure what breed he is. He has big boils coming out around his neck. These dogs are in pain and they just laying waiting to die while suffering . My mom can't feed them or care for them or even bath them or give them medication. She can't even help herself let alone call herself. Could you guys please assist asap.
