Please could you launch/delegate an investigation into allegations of birds being smuggled from Johannesburg into 27 Kiewiet Street, Joostenberg Vlake.

According to the information received, no transport permits are being issued for these birds. It is further alleged that some of the birds are being smuggled from Mozambique and that they are wild-caught. The transactions are allegedly conducted on a cash-only basis, which raises further concerns about the nature of the operation.

The complainant has advised that they have attempted to involve nature conservation officials to investigate the matter, but that no action appears to have been forthcoming.

Please treat this as a matter requiring urgent attention, given the potential animal welfare, wildlife trafficking and permitting concerns involved.

Kindly assess the information available and initiate the necessary enquiries.
