I took an Uber to Kensington yesterd around 14:30 and spotted a very thin looking dog walking in the road. At my destination I borrowed a car to go back and look for the dog.

I could not find her even after driving up and down several streets. Where I spotted her I asked around at houses if people knew where she came from. The information i gathered was that she belongs to a lady by the name Sophie or as known in the settlement as Aunty Sophie. I could not enter the settlement, too dangerous on a Friday evening. Speaking to someone in front of the Settlement was informed the dog had 10 puppies. The dog is weak she cannot nurse 10 puppies she will be dead if she does not receive help quickly.

I called the SPCA emergency number at 17:36 without success - phone just rang. Then called Law Enforcement at 18:00 and the lady Natasha informed Law Enforcement only deal with strays, barking dogs etc., but not dogs in the state as I described. She informed i must contact SPCA.

Please this dog and her 10 puppies needs help urgently

**Spotted another dog black and white who also just had pups, same area as per the picture, at a structure on 6th Avenue. She looked okay for now.

How are these people allowed to breed without being licensed as a breeder/s.
