Comments:	Upon my arrival, I met with the homeowners, Mr. and Mrs. Perumal. They explained that they occasionally experience stray cats running across their roof and, at times, entering their home through an open window. They advised that they had heard cats fighting with one another, after which the cats appeared to make their way into the roof space, where they could be heard moving around. I climbed a ladder and inspected the roof space through the trapdoor, which the homeowners had left open. Using a torch, I conducted a visual inspection and waited for a period of time to determine whether any animals were present. No cats or other animals were observed. Mr. and Mrs. Perumal further advised that they had gone out for approximately one hour and had intentionally left the trapdoor open. They believed that the cats may subsequently have made their own way out during this time. I explained to the homeowners that I could see light coming through various gaps between the roof tiles, indicating possible access and exit points through which a cat could have entered and subsequently exited the roof space. The homeowners were advised to contact the SPCA again should they hear or observe any animals trapped in the roof. No cats were found requiring rescue on the premises. Case is NFA.
