My original complaint was not only the fact that the dog got out of the yard, but it was also to go and inspect the condition of the dog.

The dog is very thin, unkept and in my opinion not being fed enough.

This must be taken seriously and investigated to ensure the animal has access to enough food.

The photo's I sent via whatsapp and the conversation I had with the inspector I spoke to on the evening I called clearly indicated my concern was for the welfare of the dog and my observation that the dog is thin and ribs and spine can be felt clearly and when you touch him.

He is under weight.

Please advise further.

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Good day Luandie,

Thank you for contacting the Cape of Good Hope SPCA. We appreciate your care and concern for animals.

Unfortunately, the SPCA cannot assist you in this instance as the matter relates to the Animal Keeping By-Law, which is enforced by Law Enforcement. The SPCA has no authority to act in terms of the Animal Keeping By Law. The SPCA only has the authority to act in terms of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962, and your complaint falls outside the bounds of our legislated mandate and powers.

The City of Cape Town's Law Enforcement division has a dedicated Animal Control Unit that is responsible for dealing with infringements of the Animal Keeping By-Law, which includes the following infringements:

- nuisance animals, including barking/noise complaints
- aggressive animals
- animals attacking people or other animals
- owned animals roaming the street and/or posing a nuisance/disturbance and/or threat to the community
- restriction to the number of animals permitted on a residential property
- breeding of animals and the enforcement of compulsory sterilisation.

Please contact Law Enforcement on 021 480 7700 to report the matter. You will be given a reference number by the call centre agent – be sure to keep it safe so that you can follow up on the progress of the investigation. Kindly note that Law Enforcement has the right to seize or impound animals and press charges against owners in terms of the Animal Keeping By-Law.

We were busy reporting it when the owners adult son came out to get the dog, we informed him of our concerns and told him the SPCA has been notified. The owner came out and became confrontational, both her and her son threatened me because I reported them. Something to the effect of.....'watch yourself, you'll see'.... I was sworn at as well.
