Good day Erica,

Thank you for contacting us and bringing this matter to our attention.

We understand your concern regarding the sickly dogs roaming within the TRA6 Delft South settlement and the potential risk they may pose to both residents and children in the area.

To assist you further, we will log a case and assign it to the relevant Area Inspector for investigation and appropriate action. The inspector will visit the location, assess the condition of the dogs, and determine the safest and most suitable course of action.

If possible, please provide the following additional information to help expedite the process:

- Approximate number of dogs - It is more or less 30 dogs that is on the TRA
- Specific areas within the TRA where the dogs are most commonly seen - the whole of the TRA
- Whether any residents know who the dogs may belong to - You can speak to my caretaker
- Any urgent cases (e.g., severely injured or immobile animals) - some of the dogs had puppies – I am not sure whether this would be immobile dogs.

Please also note that healthy strays roaming in the area should be reported to Law Enforcement, as they are responsible for dealing with free roaming and unowned animals that are not in distress. - noted yet we need these dogs off the TRA

Thank you once again for reporting this. The health and safety of both the animals and the community remain a priority, and we appreciate your cooperation.
