Comments:	Inspection Report Upon my arrival, I met with homeowner Carol Piedt, who is the grandmother of the owner of the dog. Ms. Piedt stated that they were unsure whether the dog had been attacked or knocked over and that a neighbour had alerted her to the dog's injuries. I observed a tan and white crossbreed with an open wound to the leg, bandaging to the paw, as well as what appeared to be a wound or injury to the neck. Mrs Piedt explained that the dog had only managed to walk outside of the house before collapsing and had since been unable to bear weight on the affected front paw. I explained to Ms. Peed that the SPCA could unfortunately not take the animal for veterinary treatment and thereafter return it to the owner, as the responsibility to obtain and provide the necessary veterinary care rests with the owner. Ms. Piedt understood and stated that, due to their love for the animal, they would do everything possible to have her attended to by a veterinarian. I issued Notice to Comply No. 16343, allowing 24 hours for veterinary care to be obtained. Follow-up set accordingly.
